How do I get my fingerprints taken?

All fingerprinting services are by appointment only.

All Johnston residents requesting fingerprints must have a letter of employment and proof of residency (R.I. Driver's License, State Identification Card, etc.)

CASH PAYMENT IS NOT ACCEPTED. Check or Money Orders only.

The fees for fingerprinting are as follows:

- Childcare/Daycare (Employees Only)- No Fee
- Foster Care- No Fee
- Mental Health Facilities- No Fee
- DCYF Adoption- No Fee
- DCYF Employees- No Fee
- Message Therapists- \$40.00
- Adoptions from Agency- \$40.00
- Firefighter-\$40.00
- Medical Marijuana Caregiver- \$40.00
- Public and Private School Employees- \$40.00
- **Must have letter of Intent/Job Offer for each school you are applying for.

State BCI Checks for school volunteers only-\$5.00
